Motion by Summy/Golightly to go back into open session @ 7:42pm; Bach, Golightly, Hansen, Summy, Wilson in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Summy/Wilson to approve Attorney Jason Palmer with Bradshaw Law Firm to file Defendant-Appellate City of De Soto, Iowa's application for interlocutory appeal of October 30, 2019 ruling on defendant's motion for summary judgement; Bach, Golightly, Hansen, Summy, Wilson in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Having no other business Mayor Ostrander asked for a motion to adjourn. Motion by Wilson/Hansen to adjourn @7:45pm; Bach, Golightly, Hansen, Summy, Wilson all in favor; Motion carried 5-0.
