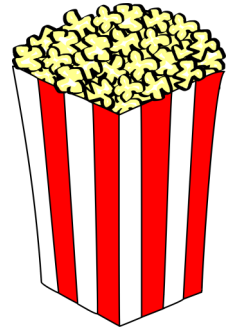
Stickers for oversized furniture/appliances to trash pickup are available for purchase at City Hall.

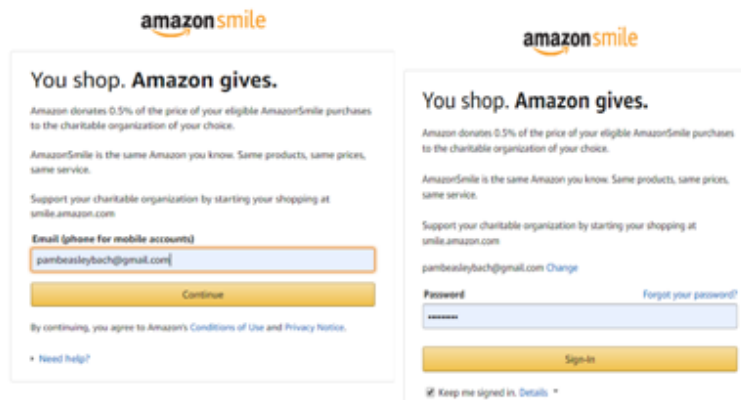

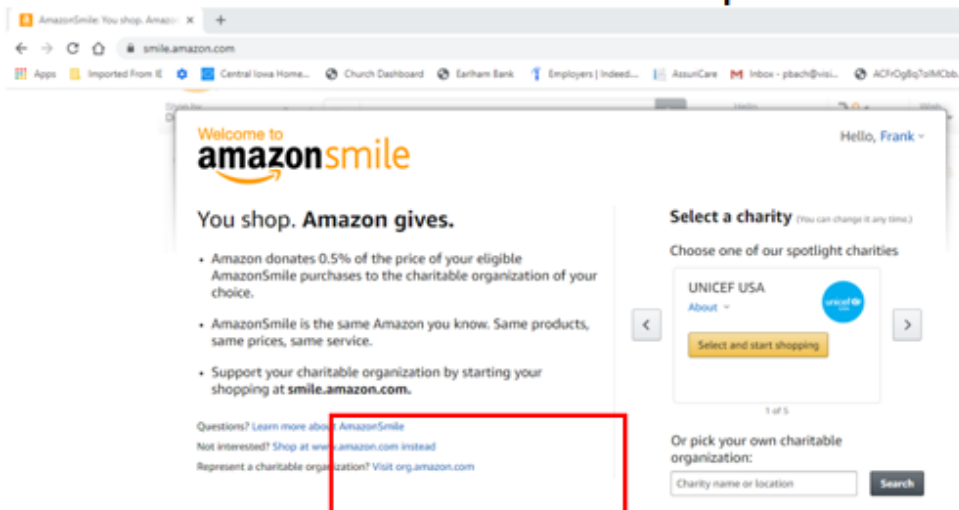

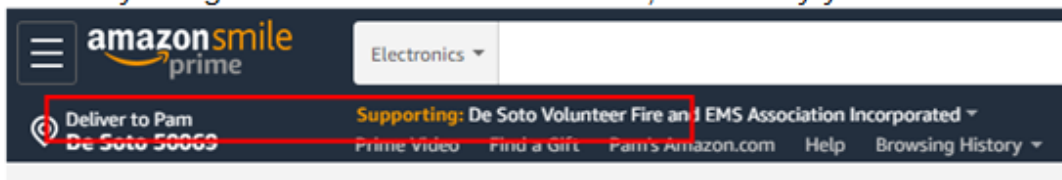
